Renders unanimously the following

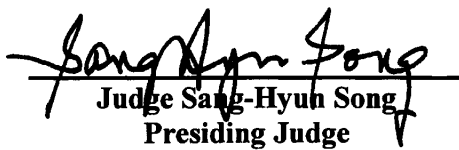
DECISION

The request to temporarily suspend the Prosecutor from conducting any prosecutorial activities related to the case against Mr Saif Al Islam Gaddafi pending a determination by the Appeals Chamber on the request to disqualify the Prosecutor is rejected.

This decision is without prejudice to the Appeals Chamber’s consideration of the request to disqualify the Prosecutor from participating in the case.
