NOTING the First Report of the Registry to Trial Chamber I (the “Chamber”) on applications for reparations notified on 28 March 2012 (the “First Report”);¹

NOTING the Decision of the Chamber notified on 5 April 2012 (the “Decision”), in which the Chamber decided that the Registry shall appoint the Office of the Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”) as legal representative for all unrepresented applicants and instructed the Registry to provide the OPCV with the applications for reparations of unrepresented applicants received so far as well as any future unrepresented applications;²

NOTING the transmissions by the Registry of 85 applications for reparation to the Defence in redacted versions notified on 26 January 2009, 27 January 2010, 14 June 2010 and 14 March 2012³ and to the Chamber in unredacted version on 29 March 2012;⁴

CONSIDERING that two applicants for reparations are still unrepresented;⁵

NOTIFIES the parties and participants that the OPCV represents the unrepresented applicants a/0198/09 and a/2917/11 for the purpose and scope

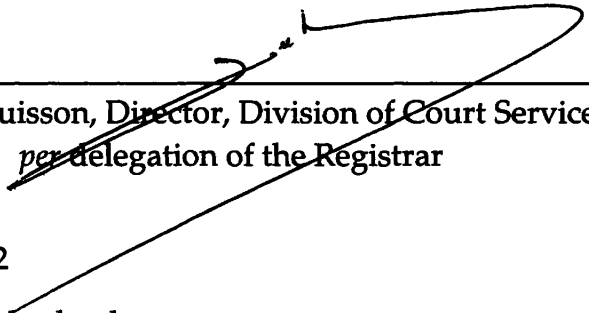
