NOTING rule 13(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("RPE") and regulations 23 *bis* and 24 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that on 1 June 2012, Mr. Kaufman communicated to the Court Management Section on behalf of Aisha Gaddafi's, a document, with two confidential annexes, to be filed before Pre-Trial Chamber I (the "Chamber") in the Libya situation and referred as follows:

"Aisha Gaddafi's request for information relating to the Prosecutor's investigation of the murder of Muammar Mohammed Abu Minyar Gaddafi"

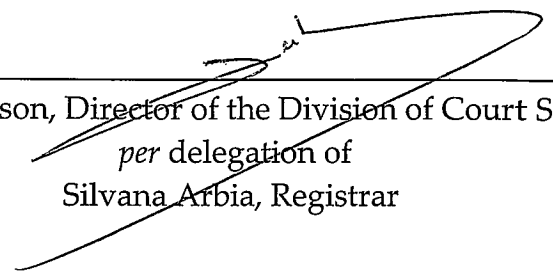
CONSIDERING the role of the Registry as the Court's channel of communication under rule 13(1) of the RPE;

CONSIDERING that by transmitting the above mentioned document, the Registry does not express any views regarding the status of the applicant which remains to be decided by the Chamber;¹

CONSIDERING that the above mentioned document may contain sensitive and confidential information, it is therefore submitted as confidential *ex parte* only available to the Registry and to Mr. Kaufman;
