NOTING rule 13(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("RPE") and regulations 23 *bis* and 24 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that on 4 June 2012 at 14h00, Mr. Kaufman communicated to the Court Management Section on behalf of Aisha Gaddafi's, a document to be filed before Pre-Trial Chamber I (the "Chamber") in the Libya situation and referred as follows:

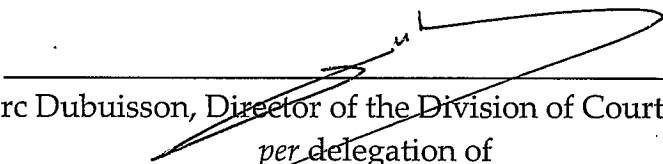
