The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”)

NOTING the “Application on behalf of the Government of Libya pursuant to Article 19 of the ICC Statute”¹ dated 1 May 2012;

NOTING the “Decision on the Conduct of the Proceedings Following the ‘Application on behalf of the Government of Libya pursuant to Article 19 of the ICC Statute’ ”² (“the Decision”) dated 4 May 2012;

NOTING rule 13 (1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, Regulation 23 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court and article 17(1) of the Negotiated Agreement between the International Criminal Court and the United Nations (the “Agreement”);

CONSIDERING that Pre-Trial Chamber I (“the Chamber”) ordered the Registrar to notify document ICC-01/11-01/11-130-Red, together with its public annexes and the decision ICC-01/11-01/11-134 to the Security Council;³

CONSIDERING the Chamber invited the Security Council (the “UNSC”) to submit observations on the Admissibility Challenge, if any, no later than 4 June 2012;⁴

INFORMS the Chamber as follows:

1. The Registry notified the Decision and the document ICC-01/11-01/11-130-Red with its public annexes to the United Nations following the channel of communication established in the Negotiated Agreement on 7 May 2012.
