Other

1. The Prosecution notes the Decision of Pre-Trial Chamber II (“the Chamber”) dismissing *in limine* the Prosecution’s application under Article 58 in this matter. The Prosecution intends to re-file the application shortly, with the necessary amendments. However, in order to provide the Chamber with the level of specificity requested in this case, the Prosecution submits that it will be necessary to exceed the 50 page limit prescribed for arrest warrant applications.¹
2. The extension is required since a full description of the 14 counts alleged by the Prosecution² will require the repetition of many details contained elsewhere in the application and the amplification of the summary of the evidence and information relied upon. The Prosecution estimates that the additional detail will require no more than a further 10 pages/3000 words.
3. The Prosecution submits that the relatively modest extension is justified in the circumstances, bearing in mind also the scale and complexity of the crimes concerned. In this regard the Prosecution notes that Pre-Trial Chamber I has previously approved an extension REDACTED³ and REDACTED.⁴

Confidentiality

4. Since this filing refers in paragraph 3 and footnotes 3 and 4 to under seal and *ex parte* filings,⁵ it is submitted as a confidential *ex parte* Prosecution only, in accordance with Regulation 23 *bis*. A public redacted version will be filed simultaneously.

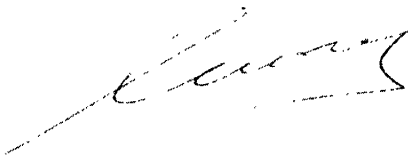
