NOTING the Order issued by Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”) on 24 May 2012 (the “Decision of 24 May”), ordering the Registry to provide the parties with lesser redacted versions of applications a/0394/08, a/0511/08 and a/0542/08;¹

CONSIDERING that on 7 June 2012 the Chamber provided the Registry with a hard copy of applications a/0394/08, a/0511/08 and a/0542/08 highlighting the redactions to be lifted;⁷

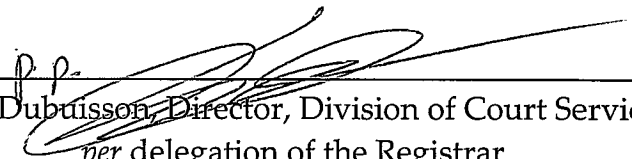
