The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the Presidency’s Decision notified on 15 March 2012, assigning the situation in Libya (the “Situation”) to Pre-Trial Chamber I (the “Chamber”);¹

NOTING the Chamber’s Decision notified on 24 January 2012 (the “Decision of 24 January 2012”) ordering the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (the “VPRS”) to report to the Chamber every three months on the applications received in the Situation;²

NOTING articles 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 16(1) and 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulations 23 *bis*, 24 *bis* (2) and 86 of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that at the current stage no judicial proceedings in which the Chamber has determined that victims may participate have been initiated relating to the Situation;

CONSIDERING that the previous periodic report³ was filed by the Registry as a confidential and *ex parte* annex, only available to the Registry, of a public filing⁴ and that, unless ordered to do otherwise by the Chamber, the Registry proposes to continue to follow this practice in order to enable the inclusion in such reports of identifying information or information relating to the protection of victims whenever necessary;

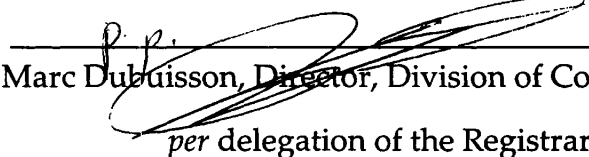
