**NOTING** Pre-Trial Chamber I’s Decision on Victims’ Participation in Proceedings Relating to the Situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (the “Situation in DRC”) notified on 11 April 2011, ordering the Victims Participation and Reparations Section to report every three months on the applications received in the Situation;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the Presidency’s Decision notified on 15 March 2012 deciding that the Situation in DRC should be assigned to Pre-Trial Chamber II (the “Chamber”);<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** articles 68 (1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 16(1) and 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulations 23 *bis*, 24 *bis* (2), 81 and 86 of the Regulations of the Court;

**CONSIDERING** that the previous periodic reports were filed by the Registry as confidential and *ex parte* annexes of a public filing<sup>3</sup> and that, unless ordered to do otherwise by the Chamber, the Registry proposes to continue to follow this practice in order to enable the inclusion in such reports of identifying information or information relating to the protection of victims whenever necessary;

**TRANSMITS** to the Chamber the sixth periodic report as an annex to the present document.
