1. Pursuant to the Trial Chamber's Decision on the protocol establishing a redaction regime (the "Decision"),¹ the Prosecution herewith submits its communication of the disclosure of incriminatory evidence pursuant to Article 61(3)(b) of the Rome Statute (the "Statute") as well as potentially exculpatory evidence pursuant to Article 67(2) of the Statute and material pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules") to the Defence.
2. On 16 November 2012, the Prosecution disclosed a total of 47 documents, as spelled out in the list attached as Confidential Annex 1. Of these, 17 items bear redactions on the content, whilst 34 items bear redactions on the metadata fields that accompany the materials. For those redactions falling outside the "standard justifications" set out by the Chamber, the Prosecution will submit an application for redactions pursuant to paragraphs 7 to 9 of the Decision.
