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1. On 5 November 2012, the Prosecution filed its application for delayed disclosure of witness identities.¹ One of the individuals for whom the Prosecution requested delayed disclosure is Witness 7.²
2. The Prosecution hereby withdraws its application for delayed disclosure of Witness 7's identity. This withdrawal is based on information received since the application was filed, which renders the application unnecessary. Accordingly, Witness 7's identity can be disclosed according to the schedule determined by the Chamber.
