The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”);

NOTING Pre-Trial Chamber II’s (the “Chamber”) decision notified on 24 March 2009 designating Judge Hans-Peter Kaul as Single Judge responsible for all the issues arising in connection with victims’ participation in the proceedings in respect to the situation in Uganda (the “Situation”) and in the case of the *Prosecutor v. Joseph Kony, Vincent Otti, Okot Odhiambo and Dominic Ongwen* (the “Case”);¹

NOTING the Single Judge’s decision notified on 12 March 2012 on victims’ participation in proceedings related to the Situation, ordering the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (the “VPRS”) to submit every four months following the submission of a Comprehensive Report on the *status quo* of all applications received in the Situation² a periodic report on applications received and the progress made by the VPRS on their assessment under rule 85 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;³

NOTING articles 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 16(1) and 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulations 23 *bis*, 24 *bis* (2) and 86 of the Regulations of the Court;

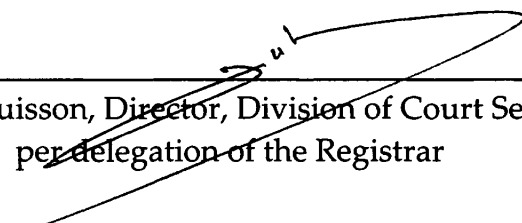
CONSIDERING that the previous periodic report was filed by the Registry as a confidential and *ex parte* annex of a public filing and that, unless ordered to do otherwise by the Chamber, the Registry proposes to continue to follow this practice as it concerns an internal communication between the Chamber and the Registry and in order to enable the inclusion in such reports of identifying information or information relating to the protection of victims whenever necessary;
