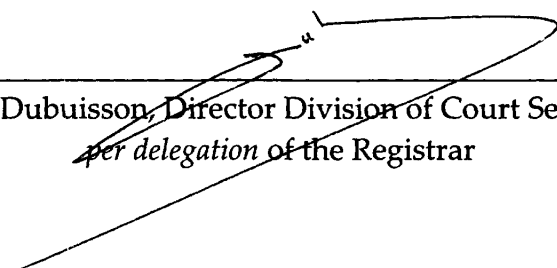
NOTING Trial Chamber V's (the "Chamber") Decision on victims' representation and participation notified on 3 October 2012 (the "3 October Decision"), directing the Victims Participation and Reparation Section (the "VPRS") to file every two months, in cooperation with the Common Legal Representative, once appointed, a comprehensive report on the general situation of victims as a whole, including statistics about the victims' population and information in relation to registered and non-registered victims;¹

NOTING the Chamber's Decision notified on 23 November 2012, appointing Mr Wilfred Nderitu as Common Legal Representative in the present case;²

NOTING articles 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute and rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

CONSIDERING that the deadline for the VPRS to submit its first periodic report on the victims' situation as a whole in Kenya (the "Annex") has started in the present case on 23 November 2012 with the appointment of Mr Wilfred Nderitu;

TRANSMITS the Annex to the Chamber, in compliance with the 3 October Decision.
