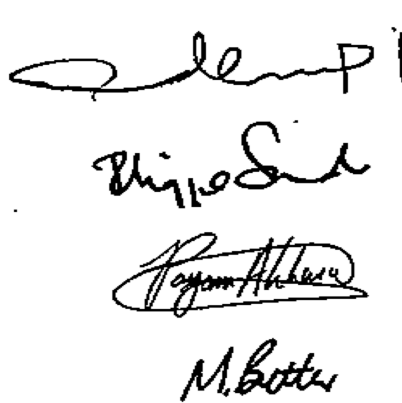

I. SUBMISSIONS

1. This Notification is filed as a result of the Honourable Pre-Trial Chamber's 7 February 2013 Decision on the "Libyan Government's proposed redactions to ICC-01/11-01/11-258-Conf-Exp and Annexes 4, 5, 6, 7, 15, 16 and 17".¹
2. The Chamber ordered Libya to file in the record of the case as confidential documents by 8 February 2013:
 - a. The version of its Submissions filed as Annex 1 to ICC-01/11-01/11-265-Conf-Exp ("Confidential and Redacted Submissions"); and
 - b. A version of Annexes 4, 15 and 16 wherein only the identifying information of the concerned witnesses are redacted ("Confidential and Redacted Annexes 4, 15 and 16").
3. At this same time as filing this Notification, Libya has today filed its Confidential and Redacted Submissions together with an English language version of its Confidential and Redacted Annexes 4, 15 and 16.
4. Due to the need to have an Arabic speaker perform the redaction of the Arabic Annexes, Libya regrets that it is very unlikely to be possible to file a consolidated English and Arabic version of its Confidential and Redacted Annexes 4, 15 and 16 by 8 February 2013. Libya has engaged a translation service to undertake this task on an urgent basis and will file a consolidated English and Arabic version of these Annexes by Monday 11 February 2013.
5. Libya apologises for any inconvenience caused to the parties by this delay and would not object if the delay necessitated the parties having a very short further extension of time to provide any response to Libya's submissions.
