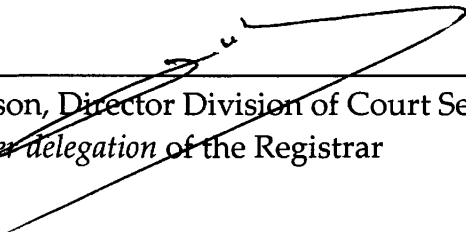
The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”);

NOTING Trial Chamber V’s (the “Chamber”) Decision on victims’ representation and participation notified on 3 October 2012 (the “3 October Decision”), instructing the Victims Participation and Reparation Section (the “VPRS”) to treat the applications falling within the scope of the present case as having been registered and make them available to the Common Legal Representative;¹

NOTING the Chamber’s Decision notified on 21 November 2012, appointing Mr. Fergal Gaynor as Common Legal Representative in the present case (the “21 November Decision”);²

CONSIDERING that on 19 December 2012 the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”) requested the VPRS to transmit all applications related to the victims represented by the Office up until the 21 November Decision to Mr. Fergal Gaynor;³

INFORMS the Chamber and the parties that on 18 January 2013 the VPRS transmitted all of the applications formerly represented by the OPCV to Mr. Fergal Gaynor.
