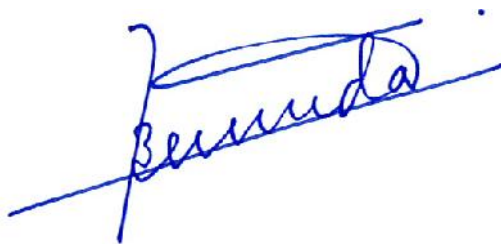

Other

1. The Prosecution submits its communication of the disclosure of incriminatory evidence pursuant to Articles 61(3)(b), 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute.
2. On 17 April 2013, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence a total of 6 items listed, in Confidential Annex A which contain transcripts of screening interviews with trial Witnesses 149, 152, 219 and 493.
3. The topics covered by these Witnesses in the course of the audio recorded screening interviews are generally reflected in the full interview transcripts that were previously disclosed. The Prosecution has however, disclosed the items for the sake of completeness of the record of the above mentioned Witnesses' prior statements within the meaning of Rule 76 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence .
