The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the Appeals Chamber’s (the “Chamber”) Decision issued on 6 May 2013, ordering *inter alia* the Registry to transmit to the parties 32 redacted applications for participation in the appeal proceedings (the “Decision of 6 May 2013”);¹

NOTING the Registry’s transmission to the Chamber (the “Chamber”) of the 32 applications in a non-redacted version, notified on 20 May 2013;²

NOTING article 68 (1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89 (1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 23 *bis* (1) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the Victims Participation and Reparations Section has prepared redacted versions of the 32 applications,³ in accordance with the guidelines on redactions provided to the Chamber in the Registry’s Report on the 32 applications notified on 20 May 2013;⁴

CONSIDERING that the 32 Applications are filed with the status “Confidential”, as instructed in the Decision of 6 May 2013;⁵
