1. In keeping with prior practice to keep the Chamber informed of the execution of its disclosure obligations, and in accordance with the Chamber's "Order regarding redactions"¹, the Prosecution herewith submits its communication of the disclosure to the Defence of incriminatory evidence, exculpatory evidence pursuant to Article 67(2) of the Rome Statute ("the Statute") as well as materials pursuant to Rules 76 and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules").
2. On 10 June 2013, the Prosecution disclosed 125 items, as spelled out in the list attached as Confidential Annex A². The disclosed items are interactive maps and statements and associated material relating to trial witnesses P-189, P-495 and P-336 as well as transcripts or translations of disclosed audio and video materials which appear on the Prosecution's List of Evidence (LoE) and the transcription of a hand-written item which also appears on the LoE. The disclosure also includes the re-disclosure of P-0256's lesser redacted statement, P-0397's affidavit, various reports, emails, investigator's reports and a letter with potentially exonerating information. Other items relating to P-0024, P-00115, P-0256 and P-0002 were also disclosed.
