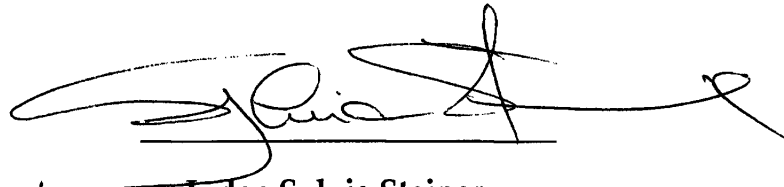
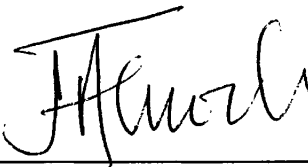

Pursuant to Article 64(2) of the Rome Statute and Rule 132(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, Trial Chamber III of the International Criminal Court in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo* hereby ORDERS that:

- a) A status conference in this case will be held at 15.00 on Thursday, 27 June 2013, to address issues relating to the timeline for the conclusion of the presentation of evidence and, in due course, the closing of the case;
- b) The attendees at the status conference will be the prosecution, the legal representatives of victims, and the defence; and
- c) The following issues will be discussed:
 - (i) Timeline for the completion of the defence's presentation of evidence and justifications, if any, to extend the deadline of 19 July 2013;¹
 - (ii) Timeline for the preparation of closing briefs by the parties and participants and for the oral closing statements after the conclusion of the presentation of evidence;
 - (iii) Language to be used for the parties and participants' closing briefs; and
 - (iv) Court calendar and scheduling issues, including sitting hours.
