THE REGISTRAR of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the *“Prosecution’s Application for Admission of Materials into Evidence Pursuant to Article 64(9) of the Rome Statute”* dated 28 February 2012 (the “Prosecution’s Application”);¹

NOTING the Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”)’s *“Decision on the Prosecution’s Application for Admission of Materials into Evidence Pursuant to Article 64(9) of the Rome Statute”*, dated 6 September 2012 (the “Decision of 6 September 2012”);²

NOTING the *“Registrar’s report on the implementation of the “Decision on the Prosecution’s Application for Admission of Materials into Evidence Pursuant to Article 64(9) of the Rome Statute” (ICC-01/05-01/08-2299-Conf)”* dated 19 September 2012 (the “Report”);³

NOTING article 64(9) (a) and (10) and 69 of the Rome Statute; rules 15, 63(2) and 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence; regulations 28 and 53 of the Regulations of the Registry;

CONSIDERING that the Registry, in its Report, had indicated the attribution of EVD-T numbers for each admitted page of CAR-OTP-0004-0336, namely CAR-OTP-0004-0336, CAR-OTP-0004-0337, CAR-OTP-0004-0339, CAR-OTP-0004-0338 and CAR-OTP-0004-0342;⁴

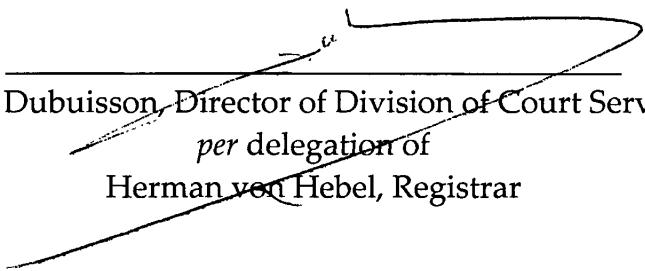

CONSIDERING that on 5 July 2013 the Chamber instructed orally the Registry to assign a single EVD-T number for the abovementioned five admitted pages, thus modifying the EVD-T numbers already assigned separately to each of the five pages;⁵

INFORMS respectfully that, as instructed, the five admitted pages of CAR-OTP-0004-0336 (CAR-OTP-0004-0336, CAR-OTP-0004-0337, CAR-OTP-0004-0339, CAR-OTP-0004-0338 and CAR-OTP-0004-0342) have now been assigned with a single EVD-T number: EVD-T-OTP-00396;

INFORMS further the Chamber that the previously assigned EVD-T numbers (namely: EVD-T-OTP-00708, EVD-T-OTP-00709, EVD-T-OTP-00710, and EVD-T-OTP-00711) are considered void and will not be assigned to any evidence admitted in the future;

SUBMITS, as public, this document informing on the implementation of the modification instructed orally by the Chamber on 5 July 2013.
