CONSIDERING that the Chamber ordered that the EVD-T numbers previously assigned to the items admitted into evidence in the present decision remain unchanged;

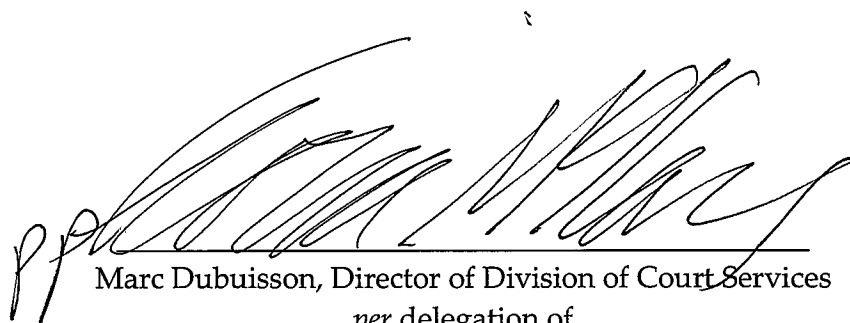
