1. In keeping with prior practice to keep the Chamber informed of the execution of its disclosure obligations, and in accordance with the Chamber's "Order regarding redactions"¹, the Prosecution herewith submits its communication to the Defence of incriminatory evidence, potentially exculpatory evidence pursuant to Article 67(2) of the Rome Statute ("the Statute") as well as materials pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules").
2. On 6 September 2013, the Prosecution disclosed 27 items, as spelled out in the list attached as Confidential Annex A². The Prosecution re-discloses: (i) a video in a lesser redacted form; (ii) the finalised version of a transcript previously disclosed in draft form; and (iii) an annex relating to a trial witness, which was previously split across two ERN numbers but is now merged. Other items disclosed include a photograph, and transcripts and translations of previously disclosed materials. The Prosecution also disclosed, pursuant to the Chamber's decision³, screening notes of non-trial witnesses as well as a letter/affidavit received by the Prosecution, courtesy copies of which have already been provided to the Defence.
