1. The Prosecution submits its communication of the disclosure of incriminatory evidence pursuant to Articles 61(3) (b), 64(3) (c) and 67(1) (a) and (b) of the Statute. The Prosecution also notifies the Chamber of the disclosure of potentially exculpatory evidence pursuant to Article 67(2) of the Statute, and of material falling within Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
2. On 24 September 2013, the Prosecution disclosed 5 items, listed in Confidential Annex A. The disclosed items include transcripts of recent interviews with several Prosecution witnesses.
3. Pursuant to the Chamber's "Decision on disclosure of lesser redacted version of victim's application relating to Witness 232",¹ the Prosecution also disclosed the version authorised by the Chamber.
4. Finally, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence an email and its attachment recently received from an individual who, in the Prosecution's view, provides potentially exculpatory information.
