1. The Prosecution submits its communication of the disclosure of incriminatory evidence pursuant to Articles 61(3)(b), 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b), and of material falling within Rule 77.
2. On 15 October 2013, the Prosecution disclosed 36 items, listed in Annex A. The disclosed items include a sketch made by Witness 2 with one redaction lifted, two audio recordings of a recent interview with Witness 217, and two items related to that interview. The Prosecution also disclosed 31 audio recordings of interviews with Witness 11, as requested by Defence, the transcripts of which had previously been disclosed.
