The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the instruction of Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”), conveyed orally on 24 September 2013, that the Registry should notify to the Defence and the respective Legal Representatives of Applicants, by 25 October 2013, those applications for reparations that have not previously been transmitted to the Defence;¹

NOTING the instruction of the Chamber, conveyed by email on 11 May 2012, that the relevant Legal Representative to be notified of an application for reparations should be the Legal Representative designated in the application form or, in case no Legal Representative is designated, the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”);²

NOTING the notification to the Defence and the Legal Representatives of the Applicants of redacted versions of applications for reparation in the proceedings, notified on 25 October 2013;³

NOTING the instructions of the Chamber, conveyed by email on 2 August 2012, that the Registry should notify the designation of the OPCV as Legal Representative of unrepresented applicants;⁴

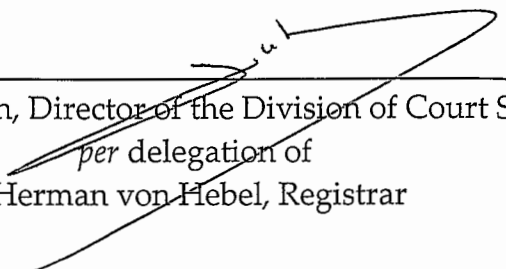
