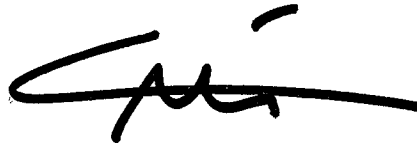

Others

1. The Registry informs the Chamber of the appointment of duty counsel to assist the three persons who shall appear before it on Wednesday, 27 November 2013.
2. On 25 November 2013, the Chief of the Counsel Support Section visited the three persons and informed them of their rights with respect to legal assistance, including the possibility of being represented by duty counsel during their first appearance and the lack of effects of such representation on the subsequent free choice of defence counsel on the list or meeting the requirements to be included. The three persons expressed their wishes regarding the counsel who should represent them during the initial appearance.
3. Mr. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo indicated his wish to be represented by Ms Magali Pirard, counsel on the list, during this hearing.
4. Mr. Aimé Kilolo Musamba indicated his wish to be represented by Mr Jean-Pierre Kilenda Kakengi Basila, counsel on the list, during this hearing.
5. Mr. Fidèle Babala indicated his wish to be represented by Mr Paul Djunga Mudimbi for this hearing. Mr Djunga Mudimbi not being admitted to the list of counsel, the Registry decided to provisionally include him on the list based on the curriculum vitae provided and the information publicly available, in particular on the Paris Bar website.

6. The Registry remains available to further assist the Chamber on all matters related to legal assistance to the persons charged by the Prosecutor on this case.
