Trial Chamber V(B) ('Chamber') of the International Criminal Court in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta*, pursuant to Article 64(2) and (6) of the Rome Statute, Rules 101(1) and 134(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and Regulation 34 of the Regulations of the Court, issues the following 'Order setting a deadline for the filing of motions prior to the commencement of trial'.

1. On 31 October 2013, the Chamber issued a decision provisionally setting 5 February 2014 as the new date for the commencement of trial.¹
2. On 2 December 2013, the Chamber issued its 'Decision on the conduct of trial proceedings' providing directions on certain matters relating to the conduct of trial.²
3. In order to ensure a fair and expeditious trial and enable issues to be addressed in a timely and efficient manner, the Chamber considers it appropriate to set a deadline for the filing of all motions that, in the view of the parties and participants, require resolution prior to the commencement of trial and which are not already before the Chamber.

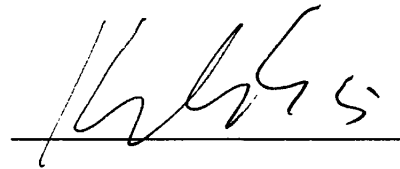
FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY

ORDERS the parties and the Legal Representative of Victims to seise the Chamber of any outstanding matters requiring resolution prior to the commencement of trial not later than 21 days before the commencement of trial, which based on the currently scheduled date for commencement of trial would be 15 January 2014.

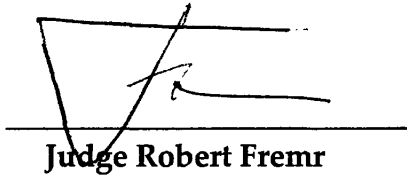

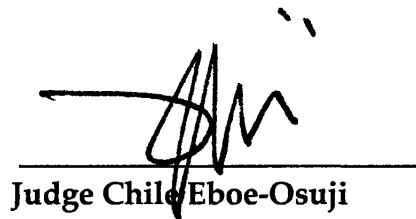
