I, Judge Cuno Tarfusser, having been designated as Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II (“Chamber”) of the International Criminal Court;

NOTING the “Demande d’autorisation de se retirer de la présente affaire en qualité de conseil de monsieur Fidèle Babala Wandu”, filed on 16 January 2013, wherein the Defence counsel for Mr Babala informs the Chamber that his mandate has been terminated by his client and, accordingly, requests leave to withdraw from the present case;¹

NOTING article 67 of the Statute, rules 20, 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 78(1) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that, from the information available to the Single Judge, Mr Babala is in the process of appointing new counsel to represent him;

CONSIDERING that, in order to ensure that Mr Babala be in a position to fully exercise his rights under article 67 of the Statute, it is necessary to ensure continuity of representation and, accordingly, that the current Defence counsel remain in his role until such time as the new Defence counsel of Mr Babala’s choosing has been appointed;

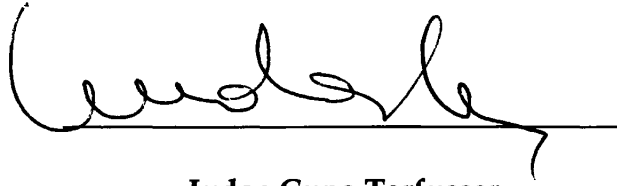
FOR THESE REASONS, THE SINGLE JUDGE HEREBY

GRANTS leave to the Defence counsel for Mr Babala to withdraw from the case; and

DECIDES that the current Defence counsel shall continue to perform his role until the new Defence Counsel of Mr Babala’s choosing has been appointed.
