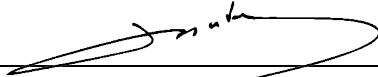
The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”);

NOTING Trial Chamber V’s Decision on victims’ representation and participation notified on 3 October 2012, directing the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (the “VPRS”) to file every two months, in cooperation with the Common Legal Representative (the “CLR”), once appointed, a comprehensive report on the general situation of victims as a whole, including statistics about the victims’ population and information in relation to registered and non-registered victims (the “3 October Decision”);¹

NOTING the communication received by email on 7 January 2014 from Trial Chamber V(B) directing the Registry to utilize the present report to relay any relevant information concerning referrals of victims to the Victims and Witnesses Unit (“VWU”) including the results of any such assessments;²

NOTING articles 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and regulations 23*bis* and 86 of the Regulations of the Court;

TRANSMITS the seventh periodic report as annexes A, B and C in compliance with the 3 October Decision.
