## I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") herewith submits the report for Rule 77 evidence disclosed to the Defence team of Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo on 20 January 2014. This communication is submitted in accordance with the operative disclosure regime, the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties.<sup>1</sup>

2.
