The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the Single Judge’s Decision, notified on 2 December 2013,¹ appointing two counsel from the Office of Public Counsel for Victims as common legal representatives for the two groups of victims as identified by the Registry, for the purposes of the confirmation of charges hearing and related proceedings;²

NOTING the Single Judge’s Decision on victims’ participation at the confirmation of charges hearing and in the related proceedings, notified on 15 January 2014 (“Decision of 15 January 2014”), in which the Single Judge *inter alia* decides to appoint Ms. Sarah Pellet as the common legal representative of the group constituted by victims child soldiers (“Group 1”) and Mr. Dmytro Suprun as the common legal representative of the group constituted by victims of the attacks of UPC/FPLC troops (“Group 2”);³

NOTING article 68(1) of the Rome Statute, rules 16(1), 90(2) to 90(5) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and article 16 of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel;
