The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the instruction of Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”), conveyed by email of 20 January 2014, that the Registry should notify to the Defence and the respective legal representatives of applicants, by 17 February 2014, those applications for reparations that have not previously been transmitted to the Defence;¹

NOTING the instruction of the Chamber, conveyed by email of 11 May 2012, that the Registry should notify the applications for reparations notified to the Defence under Rule 94(2) of the Rules also to the legal representative designated in the application form or, in case no legal representative is designated, the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”);²

NOTING the notification to the Defence and the Legal Representatives of the Applicants of redacted versions of applications for reparation in the proceedings, notified on 17 February 2014;³

NOTING the instructions of the Chamber, conveyed by email of 2 August 2012, ordering the Registry to notify by way of a filing the designation of the OPCV as legal representative of unrepresented applicants;⁴

CONSIDERING that following the passing of the late Me. Zarambaud, the Registry will consider the applicants designating him as legal representative as unrepresented applicants;

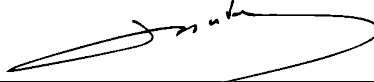
