The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the Single Judge’s Decision notified on 15 January 2014, which provides that victim applications falling under group 1 consisting of UPC/FPLC child soldiers will be represented by Ms. Sarah Pellet as the common legal and victim applications falling under group 2 consisting of victims of UPC/FPLC attacks will be represented by Mr. Dmytro Suprun as the common legal representative;¹

NOTING the Single Judge’s Decision notified on 7 February 2014 (the “Decision of 7 February 2014”), whereby the Single Judge *inter alia* decides that the appointment of Ms. Sarah Pellet and Mr. Dmytro Suprun as common legal representatives of victims in Group 1 and Group 2 respectively shall extend to the 198 victims admitted to participate by the Decision of 7 February 2014;²

NOTING article 68(1) of the Rome Statute, rules 16(1), 90(2) to 90(5) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and article 16 of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel;

NOTIFIES the parties and participants that, pursuant to the Decision of 7 February 2014, Ms. Sarah Pellet represents 43 victims admitted to participate in the confirmation of charges hearing and in the related proceedings as listed in Annex 1, and Mr. Dmytro Suprun represents 155 victims admitted to participate in the confirmation charges hearing and in the related proceedings as listed in Annex 2.
