Introduction

1. The Prosecution herewith submits its communication of the disclosure of material falling within Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

Procedural background

2. On 5 March 2014, the Prosecution filed its "Prosecution's Third Report on the Status of Disclosure of Documents Obtained under Article 54(3)(e)",¹ informing the Single Judge that one provider lifted confidentiality restrictions to nine documents on 3 March 2014. The Prosecution further informed the Single Judge it would disclose these documents on 10 March 2014.

Disclosure of evidence

3. On 10 March 2014, the Prosecution disclosed the nine items to the Defence. The Prosecution appends the list of the evidence disclosed in Confidential Annex A.
