NOTING the *“Transmission filing on Narcisse Arido’s certificate of official registration of attorney Abbe Jolles as his lawyer and notice of Narcisse Arido’s indigency”* submitted by the Registry on 11 March 2014;¹

CONSIDERING the role of the Registry as the Court’s channel of communication under rule 13(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

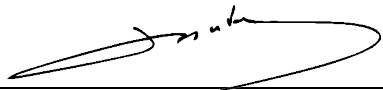
