The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”),

NOTING the Republic of Côte d'Ivoire's request challenging the admissibility of the case against Ms Simone Gbagbo before the Court (the “Admissibility Challenge” and the “Case”);¹

NOTING Pre-Trial Chamber I's Decision notified on 15 November 2013, appointing for the purposes of the proceedings following the Admissibility Challenge, Ms Paolina Massidda from the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”) as legal representative of the victims who have already communicated with the Court in relation to the Case (the “15 November Decision”);²

NOTING the Registry's Notification following the appointment of the OPCV as legal representative of victims who have already communicated with the Court in relation to the admissibility challenge pursuant to article 19 of the Rome Statute, notified on 6 December 2013;³

CONSIDERING that the Registry has received 57 new applications for participation and/or reparations in relation to the Case;
