NOTING the Single Judge’s Decision on victims’ participation notified on 15 January 2014 (the “Decision of 15 January 2014”), in which the Single Judge *inter alia* admits victim applicants a/00637/13, a/01244/13, a/01095/13 and a/01173/13 as victims in Group 2 constituted by victims of the attacks of UPC/FPLC troops and represented by Mr. Dmytro Suprun;¹

NOTING the Single Judge’s instruction to the Registry of 3 April 2014;²

NOTING rule 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 86 of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING the Registry’s standard operating procedures, which provide that where more than one application for participation in proceedings has been received from the same applicant, the first application for participation received is marked as the master and the second application received is marked as the duplicate and is given the same reference number as the first application received, unless otherwise indicated by the applicant;

CONSIDERING that after the Decision of 15 January 2014, application a/00637/13 was identified as a duplicate of application a/01244/13, and that application a/01095/13 was identified as a duplicate of application a/01173/13;
