NOTING the *“Corrigendum of the Government of the Republic of Kenya’s First Update to the Trial Chamber Pursuant to the ‘Order further extending deadline for filing of first update due on 30 April 2014’”* (the “First Updates of the Kenyan Government”) dated 29 May 2014;¹

NOTING the *“Prosecution update on the status of cooperation between the Office of the Prosecutor and the Government of Kenya originally due on 30 April”* (the “First Updates of the Prosecution”) dated 23 May 2014;²

NOTING that on 5 June 2014 Trial Chamber V(B) (the “Chamber”) requested the Office of the Prosecutor and the Government of the Republic of Kenya to file by 23 June 2014 the proposed public redacted version of their respective First Updates to the Chamber for the Chamber’s review prior to any reclassification;³

CONSIDERING that the Registry received, on 10 June 2014 at 16.06 hours, a public redacted version of the *“Corrigendum of the Government of the Republic of Kenya’s First Update to the Trial Chamber Pursuant to the ‘Order further extending deadline for filing of first update due on 30 April 2014’”*⁴ proposed by the Kenyan Government;

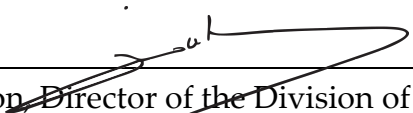
