The Prosecution (OTP) makes reference to its submissions ICC-01/09-02/11-911-Conf of 30 April 2014; ICC-01/09-02/11-917-Conf of 8 May 2014; ICC-01/09-02/11-922-Conf+Conf-Exp-AnxA of 23 May 2014; the Government of Kenya's (GoK) filing ICC-01/09-02/11-921-Conf-Exp of 23 May 2014 and the Trial Chamber's Orders ICC-01/09-02/11-912-Conf of 30 April 2014 and ICC-01/09-02/11-918 of 12 May 2014. The contents thereof are not rehearsed here.

2. This filing is marked public. It is accompanied by an *ex parte* Annex not to be disclosed to the Defence, but to the Chamber and the GoK alone. The reason is that the Annex contains details of inquiries made by the OTP and of materials recently provided by the GoK.

3. The table contained within the *ex parte* Annex to this filing sets out the current status of the various materials enumerated in the Revised Request of 8 April 2014.

4. Following an agreement reached between the OTP and the GoK at a meeting in May 2014, the OTP has (as stated above) received a quantity of materials from the GoK. The OTP is currently analysing the said materials, and assessing them for disclosure, and expects to be able to conclude and summarise that analysis in time for the Status Conference hearing scheduled for 9 July 2014.
