I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") herewith submits the report for evidence disclosed to the Defence team of Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo on 8 October 2014 pursuant to Article 67(2) of the Rome Statute¹ and Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.² This communication is submitted in accordance with the operative disclosure regime, the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties.³

2. The evidence disclosed relates to the reopening of the presentation of evidence in this case for the limited purpose of questioning CAR-OTP-PPPP-0169 on specific issues related to witness credibility.⁴
