NOTING Trial Chamber VI’s (the “Chamber”) oral instruction provided on 11 September 2014 (the “Chamber’s Order”), whereby the Chamber ordered the Registry to provide an update on the security situation related to participating victims, potential victim applicants and intermediaries in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Bosco Ntaganda* (the “Case”);¹

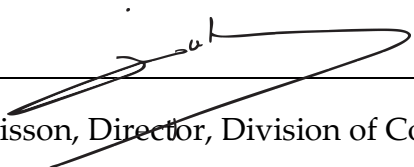
NOTING article 68 (1) of the Rome Statute and regulations 23 *bis* and 24 *bis* (2) of the Regulations of the Court;
