Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") provides notice of the disclosure of incriminatory evidence pursuant to Articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute and of material falling within Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

Disclosure of evidence

2. On 14 October 2014, the Prosecution disclosed 144 items as incriminating evidence as well as 195 items under the provisions of Rule 77. The Prosecution appends the total list of the evidence disclosed in Confidential Annex A.
3. The Prosecution further informs the Trial Chamber VI of its provision to the Defence of a courtesy copy of the keyword search terms that it has used to identify potentially relevant material within its collection and prioritise its review of this material.¹ The Prosecution has invited the Defence to provide additional search terms to focus its ongoing review.

Confidentiality

4. Pursuant to Regulation 23bis(1) of the Regulations of the Court, Annex A to this document is classified as confidential because it references disclosed materials designated as such.
