## I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") herewith submits the report for evidence disclosed to the Defence team of Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo on 21 October 2014 pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.<sup>1</sup> This communication is submitted in accordance with the operative disclosure regime, the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties.<sup>2</sup>

2. The six documents are similar to information previously disclosed to the Defence in relation to P-0169<sup>3</sup> and relate to the limited reopening of the presentation of evidence in this case.<sup>4</sup>
