Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") provides notice of the disclosure of incriminatory evidence pursuant to Articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute and of material falling within Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

Disclosure of evidence

2. On 4 November 2014, the Prosecution disclosed 160 items as incriminating evidence as well as 96 items under the provisions of Rule 77. The Prosecution appends the total list of the evidence disclosed in Confidential Annex A.
