NOTING the “Order on the submission of proposed redactions to certain documents founding the Prosecutor’s third ground of appeal” issued by the Appeals Chamber on 6 November 2014 (the “Order”);¹

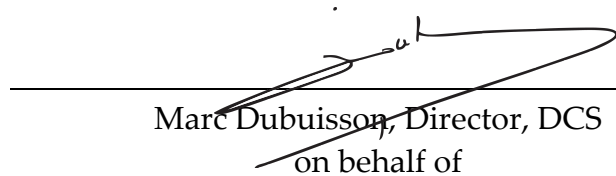
NOTING regulation 35(1) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that pursuant to the Order, the Registry is directed to file proposed redactions on 35 filings with justifications by Monday, 17 November 2014;

CONSIDERING the technicality of the issues² and the heavy workload³ currently bearing on the section of the Registry in charge of the relevant aspects;

CONSIDERING the sensitivity of the information embodied in the filings to be redacted and therefore the thoroughness required in proposing pertinent and imperative redactions;

HEREBY RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS the Appeals Chambers to grant, on an exceptional basis, a three-day time extension for the submission of the redactions, therefore setting the new deadline on Thursday, 20 November 2014.
