THE REGISTRY of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”):

NOTING the “Prosecution's Urgent Notification of Travel in the Case of *The Prosecutor v Omar Al Bashir*”¹ (the “Decision”) issued by Pre-Trial Chamber II dated 4 November 2014;

NOTING the “Decision on the ‘Prosecution's Urgent Notification of Travel in the Case of *The Prosecutor v Omar Al Bashir*’”² dated 4 November 2014;

NOTING articles 87(1)(5) (a) and 89(1) of the Rome Statute, rule 176(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber “a) invite[d] the competent authorities of the Federal Republic of Ethiopia to arrest Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir, in the event he enters the Ethiopian territory, and to surrender him to the Court; b) order[ed] the Registrar to remind the Federal Republic of Ethiopia of the requests for the arrest and surrender of Omar Al-Bashir transmitted to said authorities following the 10 October 2013 Decision; c) order[ed] the Registrar to send a Note Verbale to the Federal Republic of Ethiopia, enquiring about the visit of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir, reminding it of SC Resolution 1593(2005) and inviting said State once more to cooperate with the Court in his arrest and surrender to the Court; d) order[ed] the Registrar to notify the present decision, to the competent authorities of the Federal Republic of Ethiopia”³;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber ordered “the Registrar to prepare a report to be filed with the Chamber in due course concerning said visit”⁴ ;

INFORMS the Chamber as follows:

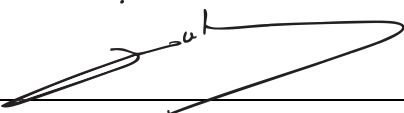
1. On 5 November 2014, the Registry sent a note verbale as well as the Decision of the Chamber to the Embassy of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia in Brussels (Belgium) by courier service and by email, as the fax was out of order.
2. To the date of this filing the Registry has not received any reply to its request from the Ethiopian authorities.
3. From the media reports it follows that Omar Al Bashir attended the IGAD Summit in the Addis Ababa in the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia on 6 November 2014.
4. The present report is filed public in line with the classification of the Decision. Annex 1 is submitted as confidential as it refers to the names of staff of the Court and of the Embassy of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia in Brussels.
