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Introduction

1. Following the disclosure on 30 January 2015 of the identity of seven additional witnesses, the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) herewith submits a lesser redacted version of its Provisional List of Witnesses, filed on 15 January 2015, lifting the redactions previously applied to the names of these witnesses.

Prosecution Submissions

2. On 15 January 2015, the Prosecution submitted its Provisional List of Witnesses and filed a confidential redacted version thereof,¹ with redactions to the names of several witnesses whose identity had not yet been disclosed to the Defence. On 30 January 2015, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence the identity of an additional seven witnesses listed on its Provisional List of Witnesses.
3. The Prosecution herewith provides the Defence with a lesser redacted version of the Provisional List of Witnesses (Confidential Redacted Annex A), lifting the redactions applied to the names of these seven witnesses.
