**DECISION ON THE EXERCISE OF FUNCTIONS BY THE FULL CHAMBER
IN RELATION TO AN APPLICATION BY THE PROSECUTOR UNDER
ARTICLE 58**

PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER II of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the “Prosecutor’s Application for Warrants of Arrest Under Article 58” of the Statute of the Court (the “Statute”) filed on the 6th day of May 2005 (the “Prosecutor’s application”);

NOTING its decision of the 19th day of November 2004 on the designation of a single judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II;

NOTING the provisions of article 39, paragraph 2 (b) (iii), article 57, paragraph 2 (b) of the Statute, rule 7, sub-rule 2 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the “Rules”); and in particular rule 7, sub-rule 3 of the Rules, pursuant to which the Pre-Trial Chamber, on its own motion, may decide that the functions of the single judge be exercised by the full Chamber;

CONSIDERING that the context of the Prosecutor’s application and the overall circumstances of the assigned situation make it appropriate for the Chamber to function as a full Chamber;

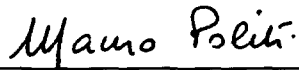
HEREBY:

1. Decides that the functions of the single judge be exercised by the full Pre-Trial Chamber II with respect to all aspects of the Prosecutor’s application; and
2. Orders that this decision be kept under seal, until further order by the Chamber.
