**Report from the Registrar to Pre-Trial Chamber II regarding the progress
conducted by the Republic of Uganda to execute the warrant of arrests**

The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”),

NOTING article 87 (1) (a) of the Rome Statute and rule 176 (2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence whereby “the Registrar shall transmit the request for cooperation made by the Chambers and shall receive the responses, information and documents from requested States”;

NOTING that, in accordance with its five requests for arrest and surrender¹ delivered on 8 July 2005, the Chamber requested to be promptly informed of any difficulties that may arise in the execution of the respective requests by the Registrar;

CONSIDERING the Note Verbale dated 24 March 2006² requesting the Government of the Republic of Uganda to provide the Registrar with a report on the measures taken to comply with the requests made by Pre-Trial Chamber II³ and more specifically on the progress of the Ugandan authorities with the assistance of the Prosecutor of the ICC regarding the DNA testing of a body alleged to be that of Mr. Dominic Ongwen;

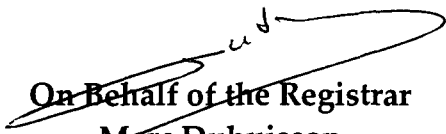
CONSIDERING that the Registrar met with Mr. Tibaruha, Solicitor General of the Republic of Uganda in Kampala on 5 April 2006;
