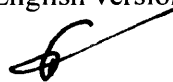

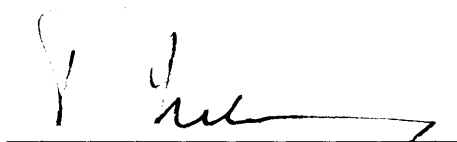
(i) The Appeals Chamber shall convene on Thursday, 13 July 2006, at 12h20 for the purpose of delivering the decision in the above application.

(ii) The delivery of the decision will take place in closed session.

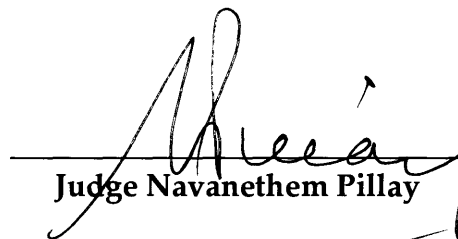

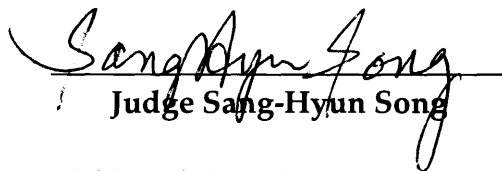
